With Android Backup Service, you can back up your data to your Google account. If you must replace your BlackBerry smartphone unexpectedly (for example, if your smartphone is damaged, lost, or stolen), you can restore your data on a smartphone running Android.

The following types of data can be backed up to an account:

- Google Calendar Settings
- Wi-Fi networks and passwords
- Home screen wallpapers
- Gmail settings
- Apps installed on Google Play
- Display settings
- Language and input settings
- Date and time settings
- Third-party app settings and data (varies by app)

The following type of data is not backed up:

- BlackBerry hub accounts
- BlackBerry contacts
- BlackBerry virtual keyboard settings
- Custom word dictionary
- SMS and MMS (Third-party applications available in Google Play)

How to change the Google Account that you use to back up device data:

If you have more than one Google account, or if you start using a new Google account, you can change the account that you use to back up your data.

1. Swipe down from the top of the screen once using two fingers, or twice using one finger
2. Tap **Settings** (Gear)
3. Tap **Backup & Reset**
4. Tap **Backup Account**
5. Tap an **account**. If you haven't added the account to your device yet, tap **Add account**, and then follow the prompts to add the account.

When is my information backed up?

- Backup manager waits for an appropriate time, then performs backup for all applications that have requested a backup since the last backup was performed.
